The most important items covered can be included under two main heads: Direct regulation and indirect regulation. Direct regulation is effected through legislation in specified employments relative to: Minimum age; minimum educational requirements for work permits; minimum physical requirements for work permits; maximum hours of labor; night work; issuance of work permits; health provisions, and inspection. Indirect regulation is effected through legislation relative to: Compulsory school attendance - provisions for both the school age and the length of term, and continuation and evening schools - school age and length of term being the two points to be considered here, likewise.
